Following the advent of non-practicing entities, external funding for infringement proceedings and the involvement of companies that do not carry out R&D is regarded with suspicion by some.

However, if only those with deep pockets could afford to enforce valid rights, there would be something fundamentally wrong with the patent system.

Litigation funding can be the answer, in particular for small companies or public sector research institutions with limited budgets for disputes.

Emily O’Neill has kindly agreed to shed some light on this concept. She is a chemist, a qualified solicitor and served as general counsel for a company that helps businesses and investors monetize legal claims.
